GENERAL INDUSTRY MEMORANDUM NO. 6-1

IDENTIFICATION OF THE GUARANTOR WHEN MORE THAN ONE NAME AND ADDRESS IS ON THE LABEL

OBJECTIVE:

This policy clarifies the procedure a firm must follow when identifying multiple distribution points on their label, provided the guarantor name and address is clearly identified.

POLICY:

Numerous feed and fertilizer labels have contained multiple company names and addresses.

The guarantor's licensed/permitted name and address must be specifically stated on the label and identified as the guarantor. Terminology such as "Guaranteed by" clarifies this point and is recommended. Authorization for this policy is found in the Commercial Feed Rules §61.22(7) and Commercial Fertilizer Rules §65.23.
